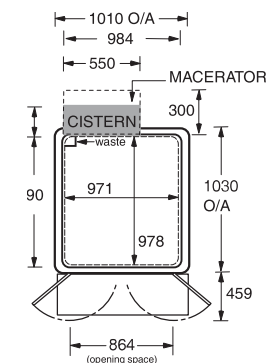
WHAT ARE THE ADVANTAGES:

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS & REQUIREMENTS

- ▶ Ramp size: 1000mm width x 430mm depth (standard model)
- ▶ Ramp size: 895mm width x 430mm depth (longer model)
- ▶ Allow 100mm at rear for plumbing services
- ▶ Allow as much space as possible for ease of user access
- ▶ 10 amp 240 volt power point
- ▶ Access to garden tap
- ▶ Access to sewer gully trap
- ▶ Located close to an openable window or door
