How it works

- » Candidate must be working for a CHSP provider within the St George & Sutherland Shire LGA
- » Candidate employment term 2+ years
- » Risk Management must be identified by the provider as an organisational skills gap need or candidate identified for succession planning (employer endorsement letter required)
- » Risk Management Skills Set Program completed by 30 June 21
- » Candidate agrees to complete a survey on their experience
- » CHSP Provider agrees to complete survey feedback on how the program has filled a gap or provided candidate with improved skills and confidence which has resulted in improved business performance
- » Candidate to submit essay as part of the selection criteria



Skill Set Requirements

This skill set has been endorsed by industry as suitable for individuals who hold a qualification at Certificate III level or higher in an area involving provision of direct client care or support in Aged or Home and Community Care sector.
