

## Health Entry Level - CHC33015 CIII in Individual Support (Pre-vocational)

### What is Smart & Skilled Funding?

Smart and Skilled is a reform of the NSW vocational education and training system. It's helping people get the skills they need to find a job and advance their careers.

Smart and Skilled provides eligible students with:

- an entitlement to government-subsidised training up to and including Certificate III
- government funding for higher-level courses (Certificate IV and above) in targeted priority areas.

### Are you eligible?

To be eligible for NSW Smart & Skilled funding, prospective students must be:

- 15 years old or over, and
- no longer at school, and
- living or working in NSW (or an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person living in specific NSW border areas, and
- an Australian citizen, Australian permanent resident, Australian humanitarian visa holder or New Zealand citizen. or;
- a NSW apprentice or a new-entrant trainee undertaking a selected traineeship on the NSW Skills List
- Previous qualifications do not affect your eligibility.

If you have a Certificate IV or higher qualification you are still able to access subsidised Smart and Skilled training up to Certificate III level, providing you meet the personal eligibility criteria for Smart and Skilled. As you already have a post-school qualification, you will pay a higher fee for your Smart and Skilled training than someone who does not have any qualifications.

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This course is a basic introduction and may lead towards roles in the Community and Health sector such as workers in the community and/or residential setting who follow an individualised plan to provide person-centred support to people who may require support due to ageing, disability or some other reason. Work involves using discretion and judgement in relation to individual support as well as taking responsibility for own outputs. By the end of this pre-vocational course learners will have a basic entry level range of factual, technical, and procedural knowledge, as well as some theoretical knowledge towards the concepts and practices required to provide person-centred support.

To achieve this course outcome, the candidate must have competently completed all 3 units as per the 'Assessment Requirements' of the units of competency. A Statement of Attainment will be issued for all units competently completed. Credit Transfer (CT) can be applied for further studies with any accredited Registered Training Organisation in the Community and Health Services sector.
